



Potential Donor Advisory

This advisory is for those of you that are considering donating money to Science Doubt or one of the projects presented there.

First – You must know that Science Doubt is not a Non-Profit organization. It is hoped that one day it will become self-financing. There are costs associated with presenting this work that are currently being funded privately. Should you decide to give monetary help to enable the continued presentation of Science Doubt, you must be aware that your contribution is not tax deductible.

Second – You must also know that should you elect to present a gift to a specific project that Science Doubt will make every effort to forward the funds to the appropriate individual. However, you must also know that some of the Guest Writers are displaying their work using a pseudonym to protect their privacy, livelihood, and/or reputation amongst peers. There may be no safe way to forward the funds to these individuals without exposing their true identity. Therefore, if after 60 days attempting to perform a funds transfer to writers, who are attempting to remain anonymous, and failing; Science Doubt will utilize the funds, as it sees fit, towards its overall mission.
